Travel by Train or Bus

Railway access via Amtrak is available from New York, Albany, and Montreal, with tickets that include a shuttle ride to Lake Placid direct from the Saratoga Springs station.

Book a ticket to Lake Placid, NY as your destination in order to receive ground transportation from Saratoga Springs Train Station to downtown Lake Placid.


